Rail Tours

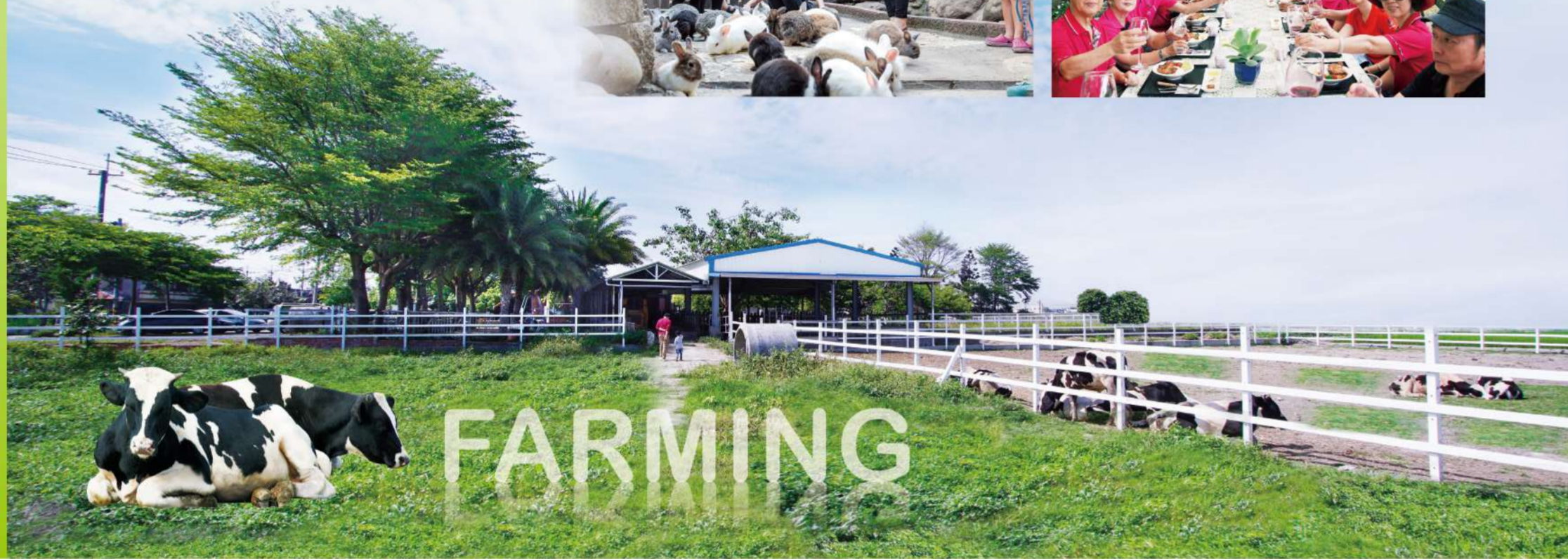
Traveling to Changhua by train can be a lot of fun. Changhua Sector Garage was built during the Japanese colonial age, and it's a treasure that perfectly preserves the Taiwanese railway culture. Nowadays, trains are brought here for maintenance and check-ups, so the Sector Garage is nicknamed Hotel for Trains. The Xihu Sugar Factory's tourism train is for transporting sweetness; the Changhua Tainzhong Township, and Ershui Station is the starting station of the colorful Jiji train. With both the Taiwan Railways and Taiwan High Speed Rail, the Changhua County has ten train stations in total, and each has its charming vibes and landscape. In addition to train stations with a rich rural atmosphere, the train-themed attractions nearby can enrich your travel experience even more.

Eco-tours

Every year in springtime, grey-faced buzzards and purple crow butterflies fly across Baguashan and create a colorful scene. The intertidal mudflats here are internationally famous for their rich ecological resources, including fiddler crabs and mudskippers moving about and foraging. There are even black-winged stilts walking around gracefully. You can also come to Wanggong for a magnificent view of the ocean and the sky. Tourists can find wetland creatures such as oysters. They can also take a bullock cart to dig in the shallow water for clams. Ershui Township has beautiful landscapes, and many Formosan Macaque wander in the woods, looking playful and adorable. Also, there are colorful flowers in the fields and rich wildlife diversities — with so many things to offer that you can immerse yourself in the beauty of nature.

Cultural Architectures

You can see the 22-meter-tall Buddha statue sitting on top of Baguashan in the distance, benevolently overlooking Changhua. The great Buddha is an inseparable part of the landscape of Changhua County. During the Qing Dynasty, Lukang was an important commercial harbor for Taiwan's foreign trade, and a crucial political and economic location. The city is now a precious spot containing numerous historic sites, and it's still flourishing due to the local religion upheld at the Lukang Mazu Temple. Also, Lukang Longshan Temple has preserved ancient music for 100 years.

Exquisite buildings are everywhere in Changhua County, such as Qingshuiyan Temple in Shetou and Hushan Temple in Huatan. Changhua County has more than 100 national monuments, county historic site, and historic buildings. These landmarks have their unique stories, which witness historical events and record the happenings.
